VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT

AIRWORTHINESS INSPECTOR (AVIONICS)

The Guyana Civil Aviation Authority invites suitably qualified candidates to apply for the position of **Airworthiness Inspector (AVIONICS).**

ROLE

The Airworthiness Inspector (Maintenance) is required to provide effective safety oversight for the registration of aircraft, continuing airworthiness of aircraft and parts thereof; approval of maintenance organizations; maintenance certification of air operators; reviewing of Minimum Equipment List (MEL), and participation in the approval of maintenance training organizations and the licensing of aircraft maintenance personnel in accordance with the aviation laws, regulations and requirements of Guyana related to agreed conventions such as ICAO conventions.

QUALIFICATIONS

• Holder of a type-rated Aircraft Maintenance Engineer's Licence who has exercised the privileges of such Licence (Avionics - Radio Communication and Navigation, Radars, Electrical Systems) for at least five (5) years.

DESIRABLE

 A Diploma or Degree in Management or an Aviation-related field from a recognized University would be an asset.

PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE AND KNOWLEDGE

- Minimum of three (3) years' experience in a managerial or supervisory position in an Approved Maintenance Organization, or an Air Operator's aircraft maintenance department.
- Knowledge, background and experience related to aircraft continuing airworthiness (avionics) management, quality systems, safety management systems, and maintenance training and checking.
- Knowledge of Airworthiness-related and other regulations and requirements, and the Civil Aviation Act.
- Knowledge of the contents of ICAO Annexes 1, 6, 7, 8, 16, and 19, and the related ICAO Documents, as well as a general familiarity with other ICAO Annexes.
