VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT

FLIGHT OPERATIONS INSPECTOR

The Guyana Civil Aviation Authority invites suitably qualified candidates to apply for the position of **FLIGHT OPERATIONS INSPECTOR.**

ROLE

The Flight Operations Inspector is required to provide effective safety oversight activities (certification, surveillance, investigation, and enforcement) on air operators desiring to enter the aviation system or already within the system to ensure compliance with national aviation laws and regulations of Guyana and requirements related to agreed conventions such as ICAO conventions.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Holder of a current Airline Transport Pilot Licence with a minimum of 5,000 hours as Pilotin-Command of a multi-crew civil or military air transport aircraft.
- A Diploma or Degree in Management or an Aviation-related field from a recognised University would be an asset.

PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE AND KNOWLEDGE:

- A working knowledge of aircraft and aircrew licencing procedures or requirements and experience in flight checking and/or flight training procedures; and
- Sound knowledge of air operator certificate and operations specifications, requirements, operator's operating and training procedures and safety management systems.
- Knowledge of the contents of ICAO Annexes 1, 2, 4, 6, 13, 17 and 18 and the related ICAO Documents, as well as a general familiarity with all of the other ICAO Annexes.
