The incumbent shall be responsible for assisting in the investigation of Aircraft Incidents and Accidents on behalf of the Guyana Civil Aviation Authority.

- Professional qualifications in Aviation Accident Investigation and Safety
- A minimum of ten (10) years broad aviation experience.
- Experience in aircraft Serious Incident and Accident investigations.
- Knowledge of the local aviation environment.
- Knowledge of the Standards and Recommended Practices of the International Civil Aviation Organisation (ICAO).
- Knowledge of the local aviation Laws and Regulations.
- Working knowledge of the guidance material utilized in the industry.

MAJOR DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Procures and utilizes the services of all needed GCAA personnel, facilities, equipment and records.
- Coordinates all activities until the accident investigation is complete.
- Throughout the investigation, continually evaluates evidence for causes and contributing factors.
- Prepares and submits the Final Report to the Minister.
